Will be purchasing a metal detector immediately and will look into funding a school resource officer position at the school. The school does not have a large budget but will be looking at different avenues.

Motion made by Misty Stone that based on the budget SeA is to hire a school resource officer at a cost of \$120,000 for the first year then around \$75,000 after then after; seconded by Adrian Lowery. 0 abstain, 0 no, all in favor, motion carried.
